Meeting was called to order by Stan Fischer at 6:33 pm. Motion to approve minuted from October, November and December 2009 minutes by Theresa McKenna and seconded by Mary Odom. Treasurer Tina Horkey reported we have a balance of \$22,373.61. GPAA did not make a profit during the Marching contest and concessions this year. Depending on how Cinderella did, we may have a shortfall of about \$20,000. We have outstanding student accounts of about \$5,600 for the fairshare fees.
