- 1. Cover Page** – Your name, Georgetown Eagle Band Leadership Notebook, Your Instrument Section, and Date turned in. Have 8 extra plastic sheets in the back of the notebook for teacher evaluations as well as a place to put pencils.
- 2. Table of Contents** – List all the items in you
- 3. Essay Questions** – use as many pages as needed
- 4. Your Handbook** – create a handbook for your section. This will show them in detail how to start from how to hold the horn, position of attention, low, horns up and horns down. Feel free to add pictures and detail. Make it your own.
